Step one: At least five groynes between the existing one at Tukituki River mouth and the at risk homes at East Rd/Clifton Rd to protect the coastline and properties. A robust but attractive seawall-walkway around the 21 existing properties under threat at East Rd/Clifton Rd. Both projects are to be considered together as stage one in a Cape Coast protection and beautification project that prioritises the most at risk areas, including Clifton, at minimal or no cost to the local community.
